



The entrance is a 3 minute walk from **Piccadilly Circus** Tube Station and a 10 minute walk from **Green Park** Tube station.










This is the only entrance to the theatre. The door to Jermyn Street Theatre is next to Papa L's Kitchen.







Once you have reached the bottom of the stairs, you will find the Box Office and Front of House area.



This is the Box Office/Front of House area. It is small and there are some parts that have a low ceiling. The steps on the right lead up to a staff office.







This will be your view to your right as you enter the theatre. The set will change production to production.





This is your view as you enter. This is the door to our bar. A staff member will be standing here and you can purchase drinks and programmes from them. This is your view as you move past the bar, there are two rows on the side of the theatre, they are rows F and G.







To access the toilets, you will go down 4 steps to get to stage level. You then cross the stage to go backstage which is where the toilets are located. The toilets are closed during the performance.



Here is your view as you go backstage, you enter a corridor with three doors for the toilets.

There are **ladies and gents toilets** plus an **all-gender bathroom.**





This is your view **as you exit the theatre**, you can reach street level and exit the building by going up the stairs on your left.

If you need to leave during the performance, this is where you can come to and a staff member can offer you help.

We recommend you bring your own ear defenders to the theatre, but we do have some ear defenders at the theatre that you can borrow if you like. Just ask a staff member and they will help you.


Chillout space
